NOW, IT IS THEREFORE, RESOLVED:

That in accordance with Section 913 of the New York State Education Law, a certain employee is hereby required and directed to submit to a medical and/or psychiatric examination by a physician of the District's choice, so that the said physician may determine the tenured employee's physical and/or mental capacity to perform duties as a teacher.

The identity of the physician and address of the physician will be provided to the employee by the superintendent at a later date.

That the Superintendent shall inform the employee of this resolution.

To facilitate this examination, the Superintendent shall also direct the employee to furnish the District's physician with releases permitting the physician to review all relevant medical records from all health care providers with whom the employee has consulted or from whom the employee has received treatment during the last three (3) years or such other time period as is deemed appropriate by the District's physician.

The District's physician shall issue a report to the Board of Education and the Superintendent as soon as possible.

That effective November 19, 2021, the employee will be placed on sick paid leave until further notice from the Superintendent.

12.2 Emergency repairs - sewer lateral

REVISED RESOLUTION TO DECLARE A BROKEN SEWER LATERAL EXTENDING FROM THE SCHOOL BUILDING TO THE SEPTIC SYSTEM AND THAT REPLACEMENT AND/OR REPAIR OF THE LATERAL BE CONSIDERED AS AN ORDINARY CONTINGENT EXPENSE; TO AUTHORIZE THE COMPLETION OF FURTHER EMERGENCY PERMANENT REPAIRS AND/OR REPLACEMENT; AND TO DISPENSE WITH THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 103(4) OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW.

WHEREAS, on October 18, 2021, the lateral extending from the school building to the septic system broke; and,

WHEREAS, the school district's architectural firm – Synthesis, LLP – has further evaluated the condition of the lateral and recommended immediate steps to permanently replace and/or repair the lateral; and

WHEREAS, the damage to the lateral is the result of an unforeseen occurrence constituting an emergency requiring the immediate and permanent need for the replacement or repair of the lateral in order to preserve and to protect school district property and to further protect the lives and well-being of students and staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS:

RESOLVED, the Hoosick Falls Central School District Board of Education hereby declares that the work and purchases necessary to repair or to replace the lateral as an emergency project; and, it is further,

RESOLVED, that pursuant to the provisions of §103(4) of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York, the Board of Education hereby finds and determines that a public emergency exists arising out of an unforeseen occurrence at the Hoosick Falls Central School District which affects the life, health, safety and property of the district, its employees, students, and area residents and requires immediate action, and that the proposed replacement or repair of the lateral must be commenced as soon as possible for the protection of District property, to maintain the structural integrity of the infrastructure of the building and for the safety of students, employees, visitors and community residents; and it is further,

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education authorizes the awarding of contracts and purchasing of all materials to repair or to replace the lateral to Hoosick Sand and Gravel, Warren F. Fane, Village of Hoosick Falls, Evolution Construction Services revised to Valley Paving, Synthesis, LLP, and Engineering Ventures without competitive bidding to commence immediately; and it is further,

RESOLVED, that all such expenditures for the repair or replacement of the lateral are and shall be ordinary contingent expenditures; and it is further,

RESOLVED, that voter authorization for the expenditure to repair and/or replace the lateral is not required where the expenditures are necessitated by sudden and unforeseen emergency events including man-made, natural disaster and other events that require immediate action to preserve property and/or to protect public safety; and, it is further.

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education is authorized to expend \$35,000 revised to \$45,000 to

replace and/or repair the lateral, the expenditures for which are contingent and do not require voter authorization and any monies received as the result of possible pending or future insurance claims will either offset the cost to the District, or will be used to reimburse the contingency fund; and, it is further, RESOLVED, that the Superintendent is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents that may be required to effectuate the permanent completion of this emergency work at Hoosick Falls Central School District. This capital project has been determined to constitute a Type II Action as defined under regulations of the State of New York promulgated pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act which, by such definition, will not have a significant adverse impact upon the environment.
