WHEREAS, the Board of Education of Hoosick Falls Central School District, Rensselaer and Washington Counties, New York, has heretofore adopted a resolution providing for the holding of the Annual District Meeting and Budget Vote of said School District on May 17, 2022, as provided by the Education Law; and

WHEREAS, at a special District meeting held on March 13, 2019 the qualified voters of the District approved issuing \$22,045,820 bonds to finance various health, safety and welfare improvements to the School Building as well as instructional related improvements

WHEREAS, it is now possible to expand the original scope of such projects while staying within the costs so approved by the voters;

WHEREAS, the said Board of Education has decided to place a proposition before the voters relating to this expansion in the scope of work; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired to present a proposition for the approval of the qualified voters of said School District in connection with the expanded scope of work at the Annual District Meeting and Budget Vote scheduled to be held on May 17, 2022; to provide for the insertion of a notice with respect to such proposition in the Notice of said Annual District Meeting and Budget Vote; and to provide for other matters in connection therewith, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of Hoosick Falls Central School District, Rensselaer and Washington Counties, New York, as follows:

Section 1. With respect to the proposition referred to in the preambles hereof, the School District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause to be included in the Notice of the Annual District Meeting and Budget Vote of said School District scheduled to be held on May 17, 2022, the following additional notice:

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that at such Annual District Meeting and Budget Vote scheduled to be held on May 17, 2022 the following proposition shall be submitted for the approval of the qualified voters of said School District:

PROPOSITION

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to-wit:

RESOLVED that the Hoosick Falls Central School District is hereby authorized to change the

scope of improvements to the school building, beyond that previously approved by the voters on March 13, 2019, while staying within the maximum estimated cost so approved of \$22,045,820, without the need to follow the cost allocations previously set forth for health, safety and welfare improvements (\$16,758,641) and instructional related improvements (\$5,286,879).”
